FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11 - AT THE NATIONAL WAR MEMORIAL

- Students are guests of honour at the annual Remembrance Day ceremony at the National War Memorial, where they will watch the solemn proceedings, courtesy of the NCC, the Royal Canadian Legion, and Veterans Affairs Canada.
- **Guided tour of the Capital** Featuring stops at the Peacekeeping Monument and the National Military Cemetery for the Canadian Forces.
- Tour the focal point of Canadian democracy Located in one of the most beautiful legislative buildings in the world.
- **Memorial Chamber** Dedicated to the memory of Canadians who have died in military service.
- **The Peace Tower** This Canadian landmark was built in the 1920s to honour the dead of the First World War. Enjoy a spectacular view from the Observation Deck at the top of the Peace Tower.
